All classes judged 50/50 on horse and rider with emphasis on relationship between horse and human. No cross entry restrictions, and English or Western can compete in ANY class. Snaffle OK at any age. Bit-less bridles OK. No martingales or mechanical hackamores in ANY class. Tidy schooling attire acceptable. *Product awards for first place!* Open schooling until 15 minutes before the first class.

First class starts at 9:00am in Main Arena

All Classes \$10 (\$8 if pre-paid)

- 1.) Lead line W/T
- 2.) Lead line walk pattern
- 3.) Lead line pattern with some trotting and rein back
- 4.) In hand class- moderate Halter and lead. Walk over rails, trot, back, pivots, etc
- 5.) In hand course- challenging Pick up feet, trot serpentine, side pass, back through etc.
- 6.) In Hand Freestyle Handlers have 90 sec-2minutes each to show off their skills. May use obstacles already in arena or anything the handler can carry in and out on their own.
- 7.) Pleasure W/ToPoll NOT below withers
- 8.) Pleasure W/T with pattern Poll NOT below withers
- 9.) Pleasure W/T/C Poll NOT below withers
- 10.) Trail- walk only
- 11.) Trail W/T moderate
- 12.) Trail W/T challenging
- 13.) Trail W/T/C moderate
- 14.) Trail W/T/C challenging
- 15.) Ridden Freestyle One at a time. Riders have 2-2 ½ minutes to show off any ridden skills they please. May use only those props in the arena set up as they are.

19.) Ground Rail Trot course- moderate Hunter type course

20.) Ground Rail Canter course- moderate Hunter type course

21.) Ground Rail Trot course- challenging

22.) Ground Rail Canter course- challenging

23.) 4 Cross rails Trot only

24.) 8 Cross rails Trot or canter

25.) Cross rail class- challenging course Trot or canter as needed

26.) Pick your own course Must complete 6 to 8 jumps. Jump each fence *only once!!!*

27.) The Cross Rail Challenge Very difficult course under 18" including trot, canter, halt and rein back. Some jumps may not be cross rails but we think the name has a ring to it.
