  - Top 12 to be called back in reverse order for 2nd round. Highest combined scores win.
  - Proper attire required. Turnout may be rewarded or penalized at the judge's discretion.

No person under the age of 18 may ride or handle a stallion on the show grounds.

ASTM Hardhat required for ALL jumping regardless of rider age & **strongly encouraged** for ALL classes.

Negative Coggins within one year required.
