Hunter Ring

Cross rail Hunter: Open to horses and ponies, riders of any age. Judged on manners, performance and way of going. Cross rails not to exceed 18"

Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 13 & over. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Cross rails not to exceed 18"

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 12 & under. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Cross rails not to exceed 18"

Only riders 10 & under will qualify for Colonial Classic in the short stirrup equitation.

Pleasure Horse & Pony: Open to riders of any age. Judged on manners, performance and suitability. No martingales. Fence height 2'

Modified Hunter: Open to riders of any age. Judged on manners, performance and way of going. Trotting corners will not be penalized. Fence height 2'

Baby Green Hunter: Open to riders of any age. Horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing. Judged on manners, performance and way of going. Trotting corners will not be penalized. Fence height ponies 2', horses 2'3"

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to riders of any age. Must be a thoroughbred and present Jockey Club regular papers or an upper lip Tattoo or written notice from Jockey Club. TIP approved classes. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fence height 2'3"

Open Equitation: Open to riders of any age. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Fence height Ponies 2'3", Horses 2'6"

Kuntz & Son Inc. Equitation Challenge: Entry fee \$30 Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on equitation. Rider must show in at least one other division. Must have four to run Challenge. Fence height 2' or 2'6" riders choice.

Low Hunter: Open to horses and ponies, riders of any age. Judged on manners, performance and way of going. Fence height Ponies 2' Horses 2'6"

Open Hunter: Open to horses and ponies, riders of any age. Judged on manners, performance and way of going. Fence height Ponies 2'6" Horses 2'9"-3'

Hanoverdale Farm Handy Hunter: Entry Fee \$30

Open to horses and ponies, riders of any age. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Rider must show in at least one other division. Open card to be ridden after rider's 2nd over fences.

Fence height 2', 2'6" or 2'9" riders choice.

Prize Money: 1st-\$120 2nd-\$80 3rd-\$60 4th-\$40

Main Ring

Halter: Judged on the overall conformation and movement of the horse. Horses are shown in-hand, in either a Halter or English bridle.

Showmanship: Judged on the ability of the handler to control and present the horse to the judge. May be asked to complete a pattern consisting of walk/trot, stop, turn, and set-up the horse correctly. Horse may be shown in either a Halter or English bridle.

Open Pleasure Driving: Horses/Ponies will hitch and unhitch in the main ring, no driving around the show grounds. All junior drivers need an adult over 21 as a sit in. All junior drivers must wear a helmet. Every driver including adults must have a ground assistant for hitching and unhitching. In the line up, every cart must have a header.

Green Horse: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Western horses may be shown two handed with a snaffle bit

Ranch: The horse should convey the versatility, attitude, and movement of a working ranch horse which include being well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft and cadenced at all gaits. The horse should work at a forward working speed with a ground-covering strides at each gait. TIP approved classes

Western Pleasure: Horse will be judged on free-flowing balanced stride while exhibiting correct gait of proper cadence. Should carry head in relaxed, natural position, level with nose slightly in front of vertical on reasonably loose rein. Offered in Green Horse, Non-Pro and Open.

Western Horsemanship: To be judged on rider's body position, seat in the saddle and ability to control the horse. Will be asked to ride a pattern accordingly with individual class specification.

Trail: Judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles. Emphasis on manners, response and quality of movement. Horse may be shown in English or Western tack. Points accumulate per rider's discipline.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under. To be judged 50% on manners and suitability of pony to rider and 50% on horsemanship of rider. Rider may use either English or Western tack.

Walk Trot: Open to 3 different age groups. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. May use either Western or English tack.

Small Fry: Open to riders 12 & under. May use either Western or English tack. Equitation may have a pattern.

English Pleasure: Judged on manners, performance, and ability of horse to give a pleasurable ride. May be asked to walk, trot, extend trot, canter, hand gallop, halt or back. Adults may ride ponies. No martingales allowed. Offered in Green Horse, Non-Pro and Open.

English Equitation: Judged on rider's hands, seat, leg and control of mount. Adults may ride ponies. No martingales allowed.

Rules and Information:

- Pre Entry Fee: \$15 per class (due by Thursday before show)
 - Post Entry Fee: \$18 per class
 - Equitation Challenge & Hunter Derby Entry Fee: \$30
 - Office Fee: \$10.00 per Entry
 - Grounds Fee: \$10.00 per Entry for non-TBHSA member
 - Checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$30.00 service fee in addition to any other bank fees
 - Proof of Negative Coggins are required within one year from date of show. Must be presented at every show!
 - Schooling ends 15 minutes prior to start of classes
 - Entries must be made at least one class in advance
 - Scratches must be made at least two classes in advance for a full refund.
 - \$ indicates Payback Class. Class must have 5 entries to have Payback. 50% of Entries through 4th Place (1st-50%, 2nd-25%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%)
 - Champion & Reserve Ribbons will be awarded in each division at the Spring and Fall shows
 - Classes may be combined, split or cancelled at the management's discretion
 - No person under the age of 18 may handle or ride a stallion on the TBHSA show grounds.
 - ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required for all Junior riders and ALL over fences classes regardless of age
 - Riders age as of December 1, 2024
 - Dogs must be on leashes.
 - Refreshments will be available on show grounds.
 - The Twin Brooks Horse Show Association, Inc. its officers, directors, officials, organizers, members, volunteers, trainers, helpers, employees, servants, workers and/or agents, nor the property owners, will assume responsibility for accidents, damage, injury or illness which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, spectator, groom attendant, animal or equipment at the show.
