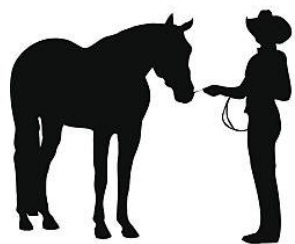

You DO NOT need to be a ECRRA member to show in Ranch Classes.

However, you MUST be a ECRRA member to receive ECRAA points!

Open: The Open Division is open to any professional or nonprofessional regardless of age or rider eligibility, regardless of past winnings. Must ride one handed in curb bits

Non-Pro: The rider has not received payment directly or indirectly for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horse(s) at anytime during the past five years. The rider has not received payment directly or indirectly for instructing another person or conducting a seminar in riding, training or showing a horse any time during the past five years. No age requirement.

Youth: Riders must be aged 8 through 18 as of January 1 of the current year. Stallions are prohibited in this division

Novice: The Novice Division is reserved for individuals with limited riding and showing experience who wish to learn more about showing in ECRRA at a beginner's pace. The rider must meet all Non Pro eligibility requirements listed above. The rider has not won any champion titles at any show or cumulative #1 year-end award in ECSHA, ECRRA, SVRA, ASHA, or any State 4-H finals; more than 10 points in any breed or national association (AQHA, APHA, etc.); or any money in a national organization (NCHA, NRCHA, NRHA, RHAA, etc.) in any western performance discipline (western pleasure, working cow horse, reining, cutting, trail, etc.). No age requirement. Stallions are prohibited in this division.

Prime Time: Exhibitors in the Primetime Division must be 50 years of age or older as of January 1 of the current year. The rider must meet all Non Pro eligibility requirements listed above.

Halter: Judged on the overall conformation and movement of the horse. Horses are shown in-hand, in either a Halter or English bridle.

Showmanship: Judged on the ability of the handler to control and present the horse to the judge. May be asked to complete a pattern consisting of walk/trot, stop, turn, and set-up the horse correctly. Horse may be shown in either a Halter or English bridle.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under as of December 1, 2020. To be judged 50% on manners and suitability of pony to rider and 50% on horsemanship of rider. Rider may use either English or Western tack.

Small Fry: Open to riders 12 & under as of December 1, 2020. May use either Western or English tack. Equitation may have a pattern.

Green Horse: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Western horses may be shown two handed with a snaffle bit

Youth: Open to riders 17 and under as of December 1, 2020.

Novice: Open to rider of any age that have not won 3 blue ribbons in a canter/lope class. May use either English or Western tack.

Western Pleasure: Horse will be judged on free-flowing balanced stride while exhibiting correct gait of proper cadence. Should carry head in relaxed, natural position, level with nose slightly in front of vertical on reasonably loose rein.

Western Horsemanship: To be judged on rider's body position, seat in the saddle and ability to control the horse. Will be asked to ride a pattern accordingly with individual class specification.

Trail: Judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles. Emphasis on manners, response and quality of movement. Horse may be shown in English or Western tack.

English Pleasure: Judged on manners, performance, and ability of horse to give a pleasurable ride. May be asked to walk, trot, extend trot, canter, hand gallop, halt or back. Adults may ride ponies. No martingales allowed.

English Equitation: Judged on rider's hands, seat, leg and control of mount. May be asked to perform a pattern. Adults may ride ponies. No martingales allowed.

Rules and Information:

- Entry Fee: Main Ring \$8.00 per class
Lower Ring \$10.00 per class
- Office Fee: \$10.00 per Entry for non-TBHSA member
- Checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$30.00 service fee in addition to any other bank fees
- Proof of Negative Coggins are required within one year from date of show. Must be presented at every show!
- Schooling ends 15 minutes prior to start of classes
- Entries must be made at least one class in advance
- Scratches must be made at least two classes in advance for a full refund.
- Classes may be combined, split or cancelled at the management's discretion
- All Ranch classes follow ECRRA rules!
- No person under the age of 18 may handle or ride a stallion on the TBHSA show grounds.
- ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required for all Junior riders and ALL over fences classes regardless of age
- Riders age as of December 1, 2021
- Dogs must be on leashes.
- Refreshments will be available on show grounds.
- The Twin Brooks Horse Show Association, Inc. its officers, directors, officials, organizers, members, volunteers, trainers, helpers, employees, servants, workers and/or agents, nor the property owners, will assume responsibility for accidents, damage, injury or illness which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, spectator, groom attendant, animal or equipment at the show.
